Participation

HSC strives to maintain a cost effective regime for boat ownership. For this to be achieved, the Club requires all members to contribute (either on demand or through volunteering) to the management, operation and maintenance of the Club. A minimum of 15 hours of beneficial work is expected between 1st January and 31st December in each year. Members who contribute are referred to as 'Participatory' Members. This time may be provided by either of the adults in a Family Membership.

Family and Single Members may elect to be Non-Participatory and opt out of beneficial work. Non-Participatory members will be levied a surcharge on their subscription and subsequent renewals at a % rate of the Family Membership agreed at the AGM. This will contribute to obtaining outside contractor support to replace their contribution.

Student and Crew Members will be excused the participatory surcharge as will Family and Single members if aged over 72 on the date of joining (or 1st February when renewing). New members will also be excused this requirement for the remainder of the membership year in which they joined. However all members are encouraged to contribute to the best of their ability.

The Participatory/Non-participatory selection at the head of this form should still be ticked to indicate your intentions for subsequent years.

Membership Application Procedure

1 Membership

Provisional membership of the Club is offered to anyone interested in boating on application, regardless of sex, age, disability, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, religion or other beliefs.

2 Proposal

Every prospective member is required to complete an application form and submit it to the Membership Secretary.

3 Application process

The completed application form will be displayed on a notice board in the Clubhouse for members to view.

The applicant will be invited to a meeting with one or more of the Club Flag Officers and/or Membership Secretary. This will provide an opportunity to explain the club culture, ethos and expectations for the member to contribute to the Club's operation. The discussion will also explore the applicant's interest and aspirations in boating.

The Membership Secretary will invoice the new member for the subscription fees due and on payment, will offer probationary membership.

Once the applicant has become a Probationary member, he/she may apply for a Mooring and/or pound space by application to the Mooring and Pound Secretary.

4 Probationary period.

Full Membership of Hythe (Southampton) Sailing Club will be granted subject to the satisfactory completion of a probationary period. This probationary period is for 12 months. The Club reserves the right to refuse or withdraw probationary membership at any time during the probationary period.

5 Refunds

Subscriptions, Entrance fees and administration charges are non-refundable in the event that a Member leaves/resigns from the Club during a subscription year.

Please send the completed form for the attention of the Honorary Membership Secretary at Hythe Sailing Club.

The form can be printed and completed by hand and then posted to the club, or scanned and emailed to the membership secretary, or completed electronically (e.g. using the Adobe Acrobat Reader 'Fill and Sign' feature available in recent versions) and emailed to the membership secretary - hsc.msec@btconnect.com.

Submission of an application form to join the Club either in hard copy or electronically is deemed acknowledgement that the Rules (and any bye-laws made under the authority of these Rules) constitute a legally binding contract to regulate the relationship of the members with each other and the Club. To avoid misunderstanding, members are advised to regularly review the Rules and Byelaws.
